Local Imposters (KRCL 90.9 FM)

Local-music radio showcase shows like Channel 105.7's Homegrown and X96's Live & Local may be slicker and more "pro," but hostesses with the mostesses Renee and Dawn lend KRCL's Local Imposters an appropriately inappropriate, giddy and slapdash edge. Sure, they seem like proper and well-behaved young ladies, à la Saturday Night Live's classic "Delicious Dish" NPR parody, but R&R's subversive colors come through in the music, spinning only the coolest of the local cool. BEST 3-HOUR, COMMERCIAL-FREE BLOCK OF MUSIC ON THE RADIO

Across the Tracks (KRCL 90.9)

More than even weekday drive time, Saturday's are the days to listen to radio—and more specifically, public radio. Weekend Edition, Car Talk and This American Life are but a few of the gems that undoubtedly have you glued to the lower end of the dial. Still, what puts those programs to shame, and may even have you skipping them if they intrude, is the three-hour block (1-4 p.m.) when M.C. Welk takes over the spinning duties at KRCL with Across the Tracks. Invariably the three hours are filled to the brim with good music—it isn't rare to hear Tom Waits, Pavement, Belle & Sebastian, David Byrne, Four Tet, Flaming Lips, Nick Cave, Yo La Tengo, Bonnie "Prince" Billy, Beck, The Kinks, Cat Power, The Velvet Underground, Polyphonic Spree, etc., etc.—and will have you dreading the chime that marks four. Saturdays, 1-4 p.m.

BEST SATURDAY WIND-DOWN

Smile Jamaica (KRCL 90.9)

On the air for 15 years now, nothing helps cap off a Saturday like Robert Nelson's Smile Jamaica, three blissful hours of reggae from the '60s to right now. Nelson's flawless, seamless sets culled from his personal vinyl and digital collection, plus the occasional mini-set of modern roots, ragga, mutant dub and classic ska, are always Irie, mon (sorry, had to be said).
